

## ACADEMIC/ATHELTIC ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS

- 1. In order to be eligible to participate in interscholastic sports at Hanover High School, a student must be a full time student, enrolled at Hanover High School. Language Arts Lab and Supervised Study may not count as one of the five (5) courses required for eligibility.**
- 2. A full time student is one who takes five (5) full-t time courses. Each of the courses must award at least one half (1/2) credit for a semester and one (1\_ credit for the year.**
- 3. Students must have passed four (4) full time courses in the previous marking period to be eligible for the sports season in which they wish to participate. Eligibility for fall sports is based on passing four (4) full-time subjects in the previous spring quarter. Summer school work does not count towards eligibility for the fall season.**
- 4. All incoming 9<sup>th</sup> graders are eligible for the fall season but must pass four (4) full-time subjects in the first marking period of their 9<sup>th</sup> grade year in order to participate in a winter sport. Initial eligibility for the spring season is based on passing four (4) subjects) from the 2<sup>nd</sup> marking period. Eligibility is then reassessed at the end of the third marking period.**
